20th HAMPSHIRE PGA OVERSEAS PRO-AM TOURNAMENT REPORT

Saturday 6th to Saturday 13th March 2010

Andalucia, Spain

Report 1: dated 9th March

John Oates from Hallowes Golf Club in Sheffield shot a seven-under-par opening round to take the lead in the Hampshire PGA's 20th Overseas Pro-Am.

Playing at Parador Golf Club near Malaga Oates took a five shot lead going in to the second round of the Tournament at La Cala.

Mike Steadman (Swingrite Golf) is in second place with Daniel Westermark (El Paraiso) and Kevin Saunders (Walhampton) tied for third.

Saunders and his team of Martin Baily, Phil Thomas and Terry Sanders lead the pro-am after a fifteen-under-par opening round.

The 72 hole pro-am concludes with 36 holes at San Roque on Thursday and Friday.

Report 2: dated 10th March

John Oates (Hallowes) has a two shot lead at the halfway stage of the Hampshire PGA's 20th Overseas Pro-Am.

Daniel Westermark (El Paraiso) is in second place with Walhampton's Kevin Saunders third and Ian Roper (Corhampton) fourth.

Oates also leads the pro-am with his team of Ian Clarke, Stewart Whitehead and David Beevers. Botley Park's Mark Smith is in second place with Saunders' team third.

The final 36 holes will be played at San Roque on Thursday and Friday.

Report 3: dated 11th March

Walhampton's Kevin Saunders shot a four under par round to win yesterday's Alcaidesa Bowmaker Tournament.

Saunders finished three shots ahead of El Paraiso's Daniel Westermark with John Oates (Hallowes) and Wraith Grant (Woodcote Park) sharing third place.

Martin Baily was the top amateur with 42 points with Phil Thomas second and Terry Sanders third.

The Hampshire PGA's 20th Overseas Pro-Am continues today (Thursday). The third round will be played at San Roque Golf Club.

Report 4: dated 12th March

Walhampton's Kevin Saunders is one shot behind El Paraiso's Daniel Westermark going into today's final round of the 20th Hampshire PGA Overseas Pro-Am.

Despite bogeys at his last two holes Saunders fired a two-under-par round at San Roque to move within a shot of Westermark.

Saunders' amateur team lead the pro-am by four shots from James Pitcher and his Romsey Golf Club team of Mark Bulley, Steve Dear and Tony Frost.

The final round will be played at San Roque this morning.

Report 5: dated 13th March



Kevin Saunders won the Hampshire PGA's 20th Overseas Pro-Am at San Roque Golf Club yesterday.

A two-over-par final round saw the Walhampton professional overtake El Paraiso's Daniel Westermark to clinch victory.

Under clear blue skies Saunders also won the pro-am with his team of Martin Baily, Terry Sanders and Phil Thomas.

Second place went to the Romsey Golf Club team of James Pitcher, Mark Bulley, Steve Dear and Tony Frost.

Botley Park's Mark Smith was third with Simon Everitt, David Huxtable and Bob Leatherbarrow.
