Other prizewinners included Edwin Holtom, Sam Martin, Bill John, Carl Winsor, Des Mander, Frank Clements and Chris Ridgewell while Darren Bartlett won the Draw and with it a new set of Titleist irons. Prizes were presented by Terry Breen, the Captain of Brokenhurst Manor Golf Club.
