Bryden wins at Romsey

Alresford's Philip Bryden won the Rotary Club of Southampton AM Connect Charity Pro-Am Tournament at Romsey Golf Club.

Bryden shot a flawless five-under-par round of 64 to take victory by three shots from Hampshire PGA Captain Chris Hudson (Southwood). Jon Barnes (Ampfield) and Richard Janes (Shanklin & Sandown) shared third place on 68.

The Pro-Am, organized by the Rotary Club of Southampton AM Connect, was won by former Ryder Cup star Steve Richardson and his team of Peter Price, Martin Rudderham and Paul Baxter. Their seventeen-under-par score of 121 was three shots better than Gary Stubbington (Hockley) and his team of Jack Stubbington, Dan Sainsbury and Paul Hawkins (124). Ben Johnson (Stoneham), Phil Dedman, Paul Cripps and Neil Pulford were third on 126.

Other prize-winners included Rosemary Hall (Nearest Pin, 10th hole) and Veronica Calvert (Straightest Drive, 18th hole). Peter Price and Paul Meacher won prizes for correctly guessing both the winning team and the winning Professional score.

Thirty-one teams took part in the Tournament which raised funds for Fairbridge Solent, supporting Inner City Youth, and the James Shears and Alan Bannon Memorial Fund (The Firefighters Appeal).
