Porter victorious at Burley

David Porter (Wellow GC) the Pro-Am Tournament at Burley Golf Club with a four-under-par round of 67.

Porter, now only a part-time competitor on the Hampshire PGA circuit, snatched victory by a single shot from Corhampton's Ian Roper (68).

Roper had been the longtime Clubhouse leader until Porter, playing in the very last match, snatched victory from his grasp.

It was Porter's first outing in a Hampshire PGA Order of Merit Tournament in 2011. Although still a PGA Professional and still flying the Wellow Golf Club flag, Porter now works full time as South-West Sales Engineer for AO Smith Water Heaters, whose business is renewable Solar Thermal Applications.

It was a clean sweep for Porter with victory in the Pro-Am with his team of Andy Wiseman, Steve Wiseman and Paul Embury. Their fourteen-under-par score of 128 was one better than Steve Richardson and his team of Peter Price, Martin Rudderham and Paul Baxter.
