Redfern wins Hampshire Open

Nick Redfern (Julius Baer) won the Hampshire Open title at Royal Winchester Golf.

Redfern shot two rounds of 68 for an eight-under-par total of 136, four shots ahead of Ampfield's Jon Barnes (140).

In third place was Sam Robertshawe (Army GC), who won the Hampshire County Golf Union Salver as the leading amateur and a voucher for £250.00. Jordan Ainley (Brokenhurst Manor) was second best amateur on 146, beating Royal Winchester's Julian Curren on countback.

Redfern had shared the halfway lead with Andrew Cloke (Sherfield Oaks) with Robertshawe and Gary Stubbington (Hockley) a shot behind on 69.

A strengthening wind made scoring more difficult in the afternoon but Redfern continued to make progress with a second round that included five birdies and a solitary bogey at the 4th.

It was the first time that Royal Winchester Golf Club had hosted the Hampshire Open Championship. Club Captain Mike Davies was on hand to present the Parkersell Trophy to Redfern and the County Union Salver to Robertshawe.
